-  Complete the FAFSA or CADAA application to apply for financial aid. It's not too late! For the 2020-2021 academic year which includes the fall 2020 and spring 2021 semesters, complete the 2020-2021 FAFSA or CADAA. For the 2021-2022 academic year which includes the fall 2021 and spring 2022 semesters, complete the 2021-2022 FAFSA or CADAA.
-  Apply for Scholarships both internally (on our website) and externally (research organizations offering scholarship funding). The deadline to apply for CSUSB scholarships is March 2, 2021.
