Spring Registration Begins Next Week

Now is the time to make sure you know what classes to register for. To do that you need to plan out the rest of your program. Look at the schedule we provide on our website. The My coyote schedule only includes Spring Quarter. Our schedules go through all of next year. See 19-20 schedule, and 2020-21 schedule. Online classes fill up extremely quickly. Make sure you register as soon as you have your appointment date. You should already have received an email on that---plus it is listed in your My Coyote account.

<u>Undergraduates</u>

Two classes that will not continue under semesters are PA 472 and PA 490. Both are offered Spring quarter. Additionally, 490 will be offered in summer session. Do NOT wait to complete your requirements.

Graduate Students/ MPA

Plan out your program using the Q2S planning sheet found on our Q2S page. Note this summer we will offer PA 680 if you are trying to take the Exam in the Fall. Make sure you check with Marisol or myself if you have any questions.

<u>Cybersecurity</u> classes fill up even faster than MPA classes. If you need a Cybersecurity class and have not told Marisol- do that TODAY. If she knows you need it, she can assist in reserving a seat.

Choose your Catalog Year

As you know- students can select which catalog year they want to graduate under-- either the year they were admitted under or the year they will graduate. Your default is the year you were admitted.

If you are an <u>undergraduate</u> and want to graduate under semesters go to the Student Success Center.

If you are a a graduate MPA student and you want to graduate under semesters then you will submit a Change of Concentration form, first to Marisol and then to the Registrar. We are modifying the form to include the catalog year change option.
