### RSP Eligibility Requirements


- Attend Cal State San Bernardino [www2.calstate.edu/apply](http://www2.calstate.edu/apply)
- Must be a current or former foster youth
- Apply for the Renaissance Scholars Program [csusb.edu/eop/renaissance-scholars-program](http://csusb.edu/eop/renaissance-scholars-program)
- Must be a California Resident or qualify for an AB 540 -nonresident tuition exemption
- Recommend to apply to EOP (Educational Opportunity Program) [calstate.edu/sas/eop](http://calstate.edu/sas/eop)
- Apply for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov) or, if applicable, the California Dream Act at [dream.csac.ca.gov](http://dream.csac.ca.gov) by March 3
- Qualify as an "Independent Student" per federal financial aid guidelines
- Complete the Cal Grant GPA Verification Form at [csac.ca.gov](http://csac.ca.gov) by March 3
- Participate in the EOP Summer Bridge Program (first-time freshman only if applicable)
