Strategic Partnership

- This collaboration enhances ASI's relationship with the College of World Languages and Literatures and strengthens ASI's presence in academic spaces.
- It supports ASI's goal of fostering academic excellence and cultural awareness among students.

Financial Value

- A \$250 investment yields high visibility for ASI through event sponsorship and promotion.
- The event provides a direct opportunity to engage with students and faculty, reinforcing ASI's mission and services.
- This funding allocation sets a precedent for cost-effective student engagement initiatives within academic departments.

Proposal for ASI Co-Sponsorship

ASI's College of Arts and Letters seeks approval for co-sponsorship funding for this event to strengthen student engagement, promote language and cultural education, and build cross-campus collaborations. The co-sponsorship agreement would include the following, pending ASI Board approval:

 - Provide a budget breakdown detailing how ASI's funding will be allocated.

- 4. Marketing & Promotions: Coordinate cross-promotions between ASI and the Department of World Languages and Literatures.
- 5. Execution: Implement event-day logistics and post-event evaluation.

No Previous Precedent:

There is no prior ASI co-sponsorship history for this event. This initiative serves as a new opportunity to expand ASI's engagement within the College of Arts and Letters and support world language education.

Additional Considerations:

- This sponsorship will establish a foundation for future ASI collaborations with academic departments.
- The impact of ASI's participation should be assessed post-event to determine effectiveness and potential long-term partnerships.
- Any unused funds should be redirected to future student engagement initiatives within the College of Arts and Letters.
