I am pleased to announce that David Maynard, a longtime professor of chemistry and biochemistry, has agreed to serve as interim associate vice president for Enrollment Management. He started his new position on Monday, April 1, and **will continue in this role until the permanent vice president for Enrollment Management is appointed.** His oversight will include Financial Aid & Scholarships, Admission Operations, the Office of the Registrar, Orientation and First-Year Experience, and Outreach & Student Recruitment.

Dr. Maynard has served in numerous leadership positions since joining Cal State San Bernardino in September 1993. These positions include assistant dean at the Palm Desert Campus, chair of the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry, and several interim appointments, including interim dean of the College of Natural Sciences.

In addition to teaching, Dr. Maynard currently serves as co-director of the CNS Science Success Center, which provides advising and non-academic support to STEM majors and is supported by a Department of Education PATHS grant. The nearly \$5 million grant, "Proactive Approaches for Training in Hispanics in STEM" (PATHS), aims to increase the number of Hispanic and low-income students who graduate with degrees in STEM fields.

A CSUSB alumnus, Dr. Maynard earned his Ph.D. in chemistry at UC Riverside. His research focuses on the organic structure, properties, reaching, isolation and identification of natural products.
