## Minors and Certificates

**MINOR IN BORDER STUDIES** (18 units). Interdisciplinary minor focused on policies, perceptions, and practices related to the U.S./Mexico Border.

**MINOR IN DISABILITY STUDIES** (18 units). Interdisciplinary minor introducing the field of disability studies, which centers the knowledge, contributions experiences, and cultures of people with disabilities.

**MINOR IN ENGLISH TEACHER PREPARATION** (24 units). Recommended for students planning to obtain a single subject teaching credential in language arts (for teaching English at the high school level).

**MINOR IN MULTIMEDIA STORYTELLING** (18 units). Interdisciplinary minor that explored the use of text, photography, video, audio, and graphics in the act of storytelling. Applicable to multiple careers.

**MINOR IN SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY** (36 units). Provides the required coursework needed to apply to most master's programs in Speech-Language Pathology.
