- The MPA program is designed to prepare students for a career in public service, the public and non-profit sectors, human resources, as well as higher ed administration.
- The program prepares students for management and analytic roles.
- This degree is intended for graduate students and career employees seeking to develop and strengthen academic and professional skills.

Why Consider an MPA from CSUSB?

- You can earn your MPA degree entirely online
- We cater to working adults with a mix of synchronous Zoom classes (held from 7:00-9:30pm M-Thursday nights) and asynchronous classes where you can work at your own pace.
- We have an excellent mix of full time tenure track faculty along with experienced professionals who have held senior public leadership positions.
- The CSU continues to offer the best value in higher education in the state of CA (CSUSB MPA=\$19k). With tuition beating local institutions (LaVerne=\$31k for MPA); UCR (\$48k for MPP).

Admission Requirements

- A bachelor's degree or its equivalent from an accredited institution
- A GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) in the last 90 quarter or 60 semester units attempted. Applications with less than a 2.5 GPA will be considered with the submission of GRE scores or proven work experience in the public sector
- A 500-word typed statement of purpose
- English language proficiency
- Public or nonprofit sector employment experience or completion of an internship

Program Curriculum

- 7 core classes
- 3 concentration classes
- Students will choose a concentration from the following options: Leadership; Community Planning and Management; Public Financial Management; Nonprofit Management; Cybersecurity
- 2 Open Electives
- Culminating experience is our PA 6550 Capstone Course

- ➤ The concurrent degrees plan is 23 fewer units than if both degrees were taken separately total of 73 units
- ➤ This <u>is not</u> a dual program; it is a concurrent degrees program.
- The purpose of the concurrent degree is to serve students who envision a career path that includes high level administrative roles in social service agencies. Earning a degree in both fields provides students the skills and knowledge to facilitate well-being and change at all system levels.
- ➤ Must be admitted to both MSW program AND MPA program.
- ➤ Supplemental application available via CSU Apply; Individual Statement and Plan of Study.
- > Student in the Concurrent Degrees Program will complete all required MSW curriculum in additional to MPA courses.

CONCURRENT DEGREES

The School of Social Work and the Department of Public Administration offer the Concurrent Degrees Program Master of Social Work and Public Administration (MSW/MPA concurrent degrees) for newly admitted students. The MSW/MPA concurrent degrees program is 23 fewer units than if both degrees were taken separately.

The 73 unit degrees program serves students who envision a career path that includes high level administrative roles in social service agencies. Earning a degree in both fields provides students the skills and knowledge to facilitate well-being and change at all system levels.

ADMISSION TO THE MSW/MPA CONCURRENT DEGREES PROGRAM

Prospective students will apply to the MSW/MPA Concurrent Degrees Program through Cal State Apply. Applicants will need to be accepted under the current admission procedures for both the School of Social Work Master Degree Program and the Department of Public Administration, Master of Public Administration. Program capacity is limited. Contact each program directly for admission requirements.
