
# Inland SoCal Population Riverside & San Bernardino counties


- 4.637 Million Residents in 2023
  - 11.9% of CA population
- +112,980 Residents by 2028
  - 2.4% growth
  - Riverside County will add the most residents in CA +63,380
  - San Bernardino: +49,600 residents.
    - San Diego Co. is 2<sup>nd</sup> and will add 61,974 residents.




## Industry Employment

- Industries are categorized by business activity
- Count of jobs (all jobs from leadership to direct activity workers to support staff)
  - A hospital employs patient care doctors and nurses, in addition to accountants and IT support to support their activity.
- Staffing patterns (share of jobs employed by an industry)
- Projected job increases

## Inland SoCal 10 Largest Industries 2023 to 2028

- Inland SoCal is projected to add 113,332 jobs by 2028
- Health Care employers are expected to contribute 14% of new jobs over the next 5 years, by 2028
- 15,800 jobs, 1.7% growth
  - 102,436 jobs will be available due to new growth & replacement needs (all occupations)


