

The Saxophone Quartet is a chamber ensemble group within the school of music which displays the versatility of the saxophone outside of a large ensemble setting. The group performs regularly on campus and off campus with a wide variety of repertoire. The ensemble explores music from diverse backgrounds/cultures and work closely with composers to bring new music to the stage. The group is usually comprised of four performers; one to a part ranging from soprano saxophone to baritone saxophone. There is room to expand into a saxophone ensemble when possible, which opens up the chamber group to more repertoire. Students are challenged to perform at a professional level and to collaborate as a group which develops strong social and collaborative skills.

This chamber group is usually open to anyone interested but a placement audition is still required in order to properly balance the ensemble out.
