Job Duties & Responsibilities

- Develop, enhance, and assess sustainability efforts for the ASI office and on campus
- Research topics focusing on general sustainability practices to create new programs to better educate the campus community about these topics
- Work with community and campus partners to facilitate programming, marketing, and maintenance for the Coyote Garden
- Recruit, train and oversee student volunteer system for students interested in assisting with the Coyote Garden
- Help manage digital marketing and social media for the Coyote Garden
- Serve as a student representative for campus-wide sustainability committees and/or efforts
- Work closely with the Inland Empire Resource Conservation District (IERCD) on garden projects
- Assists with budget expenses related to projects as assigned
- Perform a variety of manual/administrative tasks and other duties as assigned
