NURSING SCHOOL

(BSN, A-BSN, E-MSN)

All majors can lead to a nursing program as long as prerequisite coursework is completed. However, below is a list of top majors offered at CSUSB that can also satisfy the prerequisite coursework for nursing school. *It is recommended to consult with an advisor while using this guide.*

These options are tailored for students looking to acquire a bachelor's degree before applying to nursing school and/or preparing for Accelerated BSN or Entry-level MSN programs.



Kinesiology; Health Promotion (BS):

6/6 match for primary prerequisites; 1/2 recommended courses also included in the degree

- CHEM 2070 (Required) Option for GE Category - B1 & B3
- BIOL 2200 (HP Elective), BIOL 2230, BIOL 2240 (Required) Option for GE Category - B2
- MATH 1201 (Required) Option for GE Category - B4
- PSYC 1100 (Required) Option for GE Category - D3
- **Needs:** developmental psychology (recommended)

Psychology (BA):

5/6 match for primary prerequisites; 1/2 recommended courses also included in the degree

- CHEM 2070 (Required) Option for GE Category - B1 & B3
- BIOL 2230, BIOL 2240 (Required) Option for GE Category - B2
- MATH 1201 (Required) Option for GE Category - B4
- PSYC 1100 (Required) Option for GE Category - D3
- **Needs:** microbiology (required) and developmental psychology (recommended)

Nutrition and Dietetics (BS):

5/6 match for primary prerequisites; 0/2 recommended courses also included in the degree

- MATH 1201 (Required)

- **Needs:** chemistry (combination of general, organic, and biochemistry) (required) and developmental psychology (recommended)
