Why is Graduate Education Important? Jobs!



Some jobs **require** a master's degree or doctorate



Those with a graduate degree **earn more** in almost all jobs.



Employees with a graduate degree enjoy **greater autonomy** in job duties.





Jobs that require a master's degree at an entrylevel are projected to grow by 15% between 2019 and 2029, the fastest across all education levels.

What are the types of graduate degrees?

- < Master's degrees (M.A., M.S., M.B.A., M.P.A., M.S.W., M.P.H., M.F.A., M.M., M.A.T., Ed.S.)
- Provides specialized education in specific disciplines
- Provides more work autonomy than bachelor's degrees
- Typically 2 years to complete
- Most students pay tuition, and financial aid is often available
- Leads to careers in industry and K-12 education





What are the types of graduate degrees?

- < Professional Doctorates (M.D., D.D.S., J.D., D.V.M., Dr.P.H., Au.D., D.N.P., O.T.D, D.O.T, D.P.T, D.P.A. Ed.D.)
- Terminal degrees in specific disciplines (ex., medicine, law)
- Most students pay tuition; financial aid varies
- Typically 3-4 years to complete
- Leads to professional careers as doctors, lawyers, dentists, etc.





What are the types of graduate degrees?

- < Research Doctorates (Ph.D.)
- Terminal degrees in academic disciplines
- Tuition is typically waived and stipend paid
- Typically 4+ years to complete
- Leads to careers in industry or university education





Am I qualified for a graduate program?

< Yes!

- < If you have or will have an undergraduate degree
- < If you have a strong interest in the subject
- < If you are willing to work hard





Coyote Accelerated Postbaccalaureate Education (CAPE)

- < Blended programs are coming!
- Share up to 12 units
 between undergraduate
 and master's degrees
- < Apply after completing 60 units
- < Talk to you department chair!





What do Admissions Committees Look at in Candidates?

- Grades (but not straight As)
- Standardized test scores (less and less common)
- Letters of recommendation
- Personal statement or letter of intent
- Prior experience (undergraduate research, work, volunteer service)
- Perhaps a writing sample
- Evidence of work ethic and resilience






How Do I Find the Right Graduate Program?

- < How do I begin searching for programs?

When Should You Apply?

- Check the program's application
 deadline NOW to ensure you have time
 to prepare your application
- < Know the application requirements
- < Program deadlines vary





Financial Opportunities

- < Graduate Equity Fellowship: \$500-\$2,000 a year.
- < State University Grant
- < Student Research and Travel:
 - Up to \$1,000 per academic year
- < California Pre-Doctoral Program:
 - \$5,000 funds to explore and prepare for grad school.
- < Chancellor's Doctoral Incentive Program:
 - Grants, up to \$30,000 in forgivable loans, and much more.
- < Merit-Based Presidential Scholarship:
 - NEW non-resident students, up to \$6,000 in scholarships per academic year, up to \$24,000 total for 4 years.
- < Assistantships
- < Fellowships










CSUSB Graduate Alumni Spotlights
